TEEN CREATIVE PROJECTS for AGES 13-18

Welcome to a whole new summer teen experience! Arts Enterprise is an enriching program in which participants will focus on one creative arts discipline for the entire week. During the day, we'll move to various locations around downtown Cincinnati, and use the cityscape to enhance imagination and creativity.

Arts Enterprise has been developed to provide an authentic and exclusive arts experience. Participants will deep dive into their selected discipline. We'll be working with our partners Visionaries + Voices, Cincinnati Ballet and Ensemble Theatre Cincinnati to guide participants during project creation.

Participants will end the week by showcasing their projects via art installations and performances.

In order to provide an immersive experience, registration is limited to five participants per discipline. In addition, those wishing to attend will need to submit a project sample that expresses their interest in the preferred discipline.

Moving Around Town - Melodic Connections' qualified, trusted staff along with college-age volunteers and vetted community partners will chaperone participants as we introduce them to new parts of the community.
